

BUSINESS LAW

Business law is a course that covers basic laws and material that is practical and necessary for everyone in everyday living. Rights and responsibilities of minors and adults are compared. During the semester, it reviews the effect that law has on society. Guest speakers are used to cover specific topic related to the study.

Projects:

If the student has an extended absence, he/she will be given adequate time to make-up the work. The student should seek out the teacher for any work that is missed.
